

## **AREA 15 PI/CPC COMMITTEE**

### **Composition:**

All District PI/CPC Chairpersons are members. The Committee Chairperson, Alternate Chairperson, and the Secretary/Treasurer are elected in Committee from current or rotating out PI/CPC District Chairpersons and past PI/CPC District Chairpersons, using the Third Legacy Procedure. Newly elected officers are presented for approval at the Area business meeting.

### **Scope:**

Offers a forum for the Districts to share their experience in carrying the A.A. message to the general public and to the professionals who, in their work, come in contact with alcoholics. Assist each other in the creation and operation of effective District PI/CPC Committees.

### **Procedure:**

Holds quarterly meetings where Districts may share their experience. Each District submits a written report of District PI/CPC activities which becomes a part of the Committee minutes. Serves as a communication channel to and from the PI/CPC desks at G.S.O. Communicates with the Area Delegate. Presents a report of Committee activities orally at the Area business meeting and in written form for inclusion in the Area minutes. Provides the Area Finance Committee with an annual request for funds at budget time.
